Opening doors to Swiss and international universities







At Chantemerle, the ideal age for international students to enter the Swiss pathway is between 12 and 15 years old, allowing students enough time to learn French and build a strong foundation in mathematics and science before progressing to high school (also called "Gymnase" in Switzerland).

The federal Matura diploma is the Swiss qualification obtained after 3 years of high school studies. The diploma provides direct access to all Swiss public universities including to ETH Zurich or EPFL Lausanne and is widely accepted by institutions around the world.

International students who obtain the Matura are granted the same status and rights as Swiss students when applying to Swiss universities — including automatic admission into public universities at the same tuition fees, which are among the lowest in Europe.

- Weekly assessments: Students take regular tests each week to track their progress, reinforce learning, and identify areas needing improvement.
- Regular homework: Regular assignments and supervised study sessions ensure progress monitoring and the development of good study habits and self-discipline.
- Use of Past Papers: Students frequently work with past exam papers, helping them become familiar with exam formats and time management.
- **Small classes and experienced:** Highly qualified and experienced teachers work with small groups, allowing for personalized instruction
- A well-balanced and healthy environment, combining sports, friendships, nature, outdoor adventures, and excursions.

This well-rounded, supportive environment helps students build confidence, master their subjects, and achieve strong academic results.










The Swiss pathway at Chantemerle

Chantemerle's Swiss pathway prepares Swiss and international students for the Swiss Federal Matura Diploma. The programme is taught in French.

At Chantemerle, the ideal age to enter the Swiss academic pathway is between 12 and 15 years old, allowing international students enough time to learn French and build a strong foundation in mathematics and science before progressing to high school.

Chantemerle's **French integration programme** is designed for international students new to French. Over the course of 1 or 2 years, students follow intensive French language classes combined with core subjects taught in French (maths, science, and humanities). The goal is to help each student reach at least a B1 level in French, build academic confidence, and integrate smoothly into the Swiss high school programme.





The Swiss Matura diploma programme

The federal Matura diploma is the Swiss qualification obtained after 3 years of high school studies. The programme is taught in French.

The programme is open to international students with at least a B1 level in French or enrolled in Chantemerle's French integration programme. A bilingual French/English option is available as an option.

International students who obtain the Matura are granted the **same status and rights as Swiss students** when applying to Swiss universities — including automatic admission into public universities at the same tuition fees, which are among the lowest in Europe.
