

A boarding school in the spirit of Switzerland

Safe, stable, and internationally recognized, Switzerland offers a unique mix of academic excellence and high quality of life.

Founded and run by the Wegmüller family since 1966, Chantemerle is a private, international boarding school beautifully located in nature, overlooking Lake Geneva and the Alps. Intentionally small and personalized, Chantemerle welcomes an exclusive community of 65 students ages 6 to 18, of whom 60% are Swiss.

Over the years, we have developed a unique educational model centered around a healthy and balanced lifestyle, traditional values and the culture of effort. It is this balanced model that makes our school so strong and unique.

Chantemerle proposes competitive, cost-effective boarding and tuition fees for families seeking a premium Swiss education.









Traditional and efficient learning methods

At Chantemerle, we combine traditional teaching methods with innovative, hands-on learning. Without screens or distractions, students learn to think logically, communicate clearly, and apply their knowledge creatively in real-world contexts:

- **Weekly assessments:** Students take regular tests each week to track their progress, reinforce learning, and identify areas needing improvement.
- Regular homework: Regular assignments and supervised study sessions ensure progress monitoring and the development of good study habits and self-discipline.
- Use of Past Papers: Students frequently work with past exam papers, helping them become familiar with exam formats and time management.
- **Small classes and experienced:** Highly qualified and experienced teachers work with small groups, allowing for personalized instruction
- A well-balanced and healthy environment, combining sports, friendships, nature, outdoor adventures, and excursions.

This well-rounded, supportive environment helps students build confidence, master their subjects, and achieve strong academic results.









The Cambridge International curriculum at Chantemerle


The Cambridge programme offers an internationally recognized alternative to the IB diploma or the Swiss Matura.

Open to international students with at least B1 English level or those enrolled in our English integration programme, it is particularly well suited for students seeking a lighter yet focused academic pathway in English: elite athletes and students with special educational needs.

This curriculum provides strong preparation for universities in the US, UK, Australia or Canada.

Students typically enter the programme at age 14 and prepare six IGCSE subjects for 2 years, followed by three A Level subjects they study for two more years, allowing them to specialize in areas of strength and interest.







Cambridge IGCSE

Cambridge Secondary 2 is typically for learners aged 14 to 16 years. Chantemerle proposes a selection of subjects that are aligned to the standard requirements for admission to Universities and Engineering Schools worldwide.
